Youth Board Member Profile, Responsibilities and Terms of Office

- A Youth Board Member of Junior Achievement of Eastern Oklahoma, Inc. is selected by a nomination process. Teachers utilizing JA curriculum are eligible to nominate students to be considered for board membership. Students will be nominated at the end of their Sophomore year to serve during their Junior year of high school.
- The selection committee will consist of the President, Program Director, Development Director and two members of the Executive Committee.
- Students must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be in good standing with their school.
- He or she should be willing to help secure financial and volunteer support from his or her contacts and from additional sources.
- He or she will be asked to actively serve on one committee.
- Each Youth Board Member will be asked to make a personal contribution.
- There are four board meetings per year. All members should attend at least three meetings. A board member should also attend the annual meeting.
- Each new Youth Board Member will be required to attend an orientation and as part of the orientation, the new member will be expected to observe one Junior Achievement class other than one they have already participated in.
- A Youth Board Member (Junior in high school) is elected for a one-year term. If they successfully participate during their first year, they will be invited back for a second year. To start the process during the first year, two students will be selected for Board membership (one sophomore and one junior), thereafter one student will be elected per year.
